The mission of Renaissance Academy is to develop caring engaged citizens and thoughtful learners.

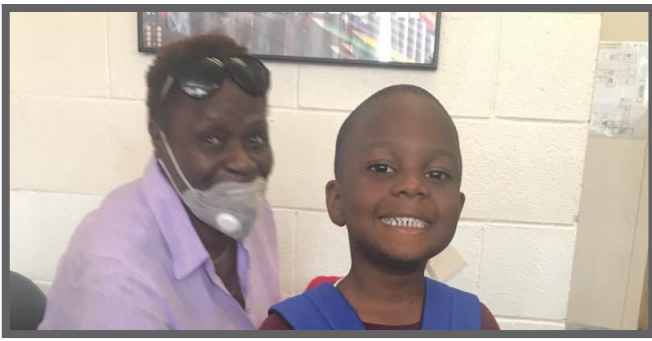
Sponsor Statement

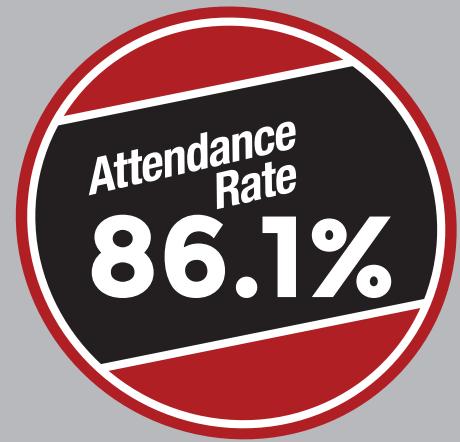

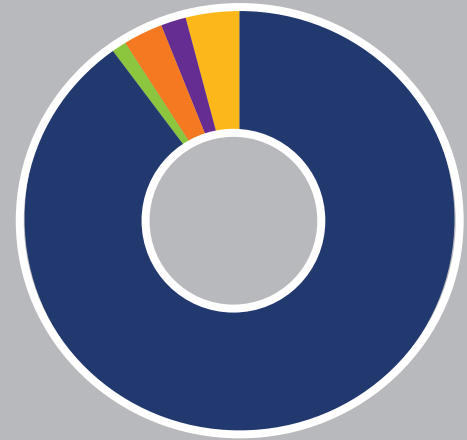

Academic Goals

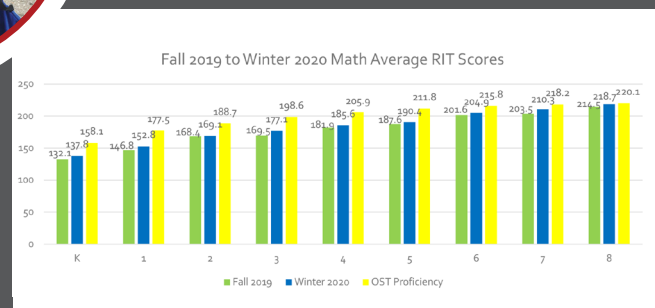
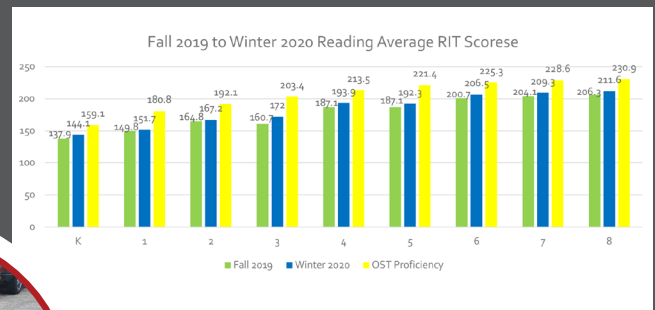
The school will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient in all subgroups in reading and math by 25% on the state mandated test through access to high-quality learning opportunities by highly qualified teachers and support staff.

The school will implement individual intervention supports and services, community partnerships, and family engagement initiatives that work together to create a positive, safe, and engaging learning environment that reinforces academic achievement goals for all students, resulting in an increase in student proficiency on state mandated testing of 25%.

The school will increase the positive culture and climate of the school and its supports by providing a structured and tiered PBIS framework while increasing parent engagement and community supports, resulting in a decrease in behavioral suspensions by 25%, and also resulting in the school meeting the improvement standard for the chronic absenteeism indicator on the school report card.

School Grade

School Overview
